Rev. Billy Graham, a North Carolina dairy farmer's son who preached to millions in crusades, who become a pastor to

presidents and the nation's best-known Christian evangelist for more than 60 years, died on Wednesday at his home in Montreat, N.C. He was 99. In 2007, the Billy Graham Evangelistic Association estimated that he had preached the Gospel to more than 215 million people in more than 185 countries and territories since beginning his crusades in October, 1947 in Grand Rapids, Michigan. He reached hundreds of millions more on television, through video and in film. "This is not mass evangelism", Mr. Graham liked to say, "but personal evangelism on a mass scale". In November, 1995 on his 77th birthday, Mr. Graham named Franklin to succeed him as head of the Billy Graham Evangelistic Association. His daughter, Anne Graham Lotz, and his grandson, Will Graham, are also in ministry. His body will lie in honor at the Capitol Rotunda in Washington, D.C., this Wednesday & Thursday and will be open to the public.
