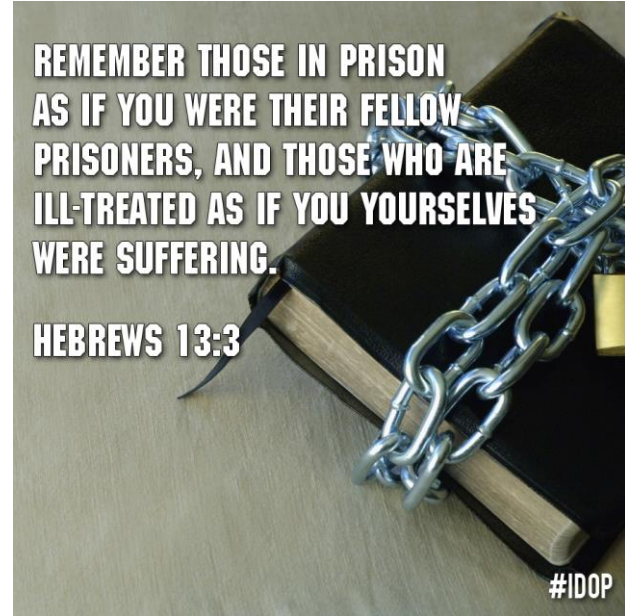

The Camp Haluwasa Puppet Team, led by the camp program director, Pastor George Devo, was greatly received with enthusiasm by BBCers last Sunday morning. The name, "Haluwasa", is made up from letters of the song, "Hallelujah, What a Savior" and represents the theme of the camp. The camp is located just north of Hammonton on 188 acres with three lakes. Camping has had a great influence in my life and in the life of thousands of young people who made commitments to Christ. I want to encourage our children and teens to spend a week at camp this summer. Activities include swimming, boating, fishing, hiking, outdoor games, crafts, campfires, Bible Stories, nature trails, and much more! **Here are the age-group categories for the 6-day overnight camps:**

1. Frontier Village – (ages 6-9) & Wranglers (ages 8-9).
2. Tall Pines Territory (Ages 10-11).
3. Wilderness Outpost (Ages 12-13).
4. Tee Pee Town (Ages 14-16).

Campers can pick the week they wish to participate:

1. Week 1 – July 9-14.
2. Week 2 – July 16-21.
3. Week 3 – July 23-28.
4. Week 4 – July 30-August 4.
5. Week 5 -- August 6-11.

The cost is \$495 for the 6-day, overnight camps. **Someone in our church has offered to sponsor the entire week for the first camper who signs up!** Maybe others in our church family would like to sponsor all or partial cost for a camper.
