As we celebrate America's Independence Day, our nation is facing a critical time in its history. We have faced many such times over the past 241 years. The Revolutionary War was fought for our independence from England after the signing of the Declaration of Independence, which we celebrate Tuesday on July 4th. George Washington was the leader God raised up to deliver us. During the War of 1812, the British burned down the White House in Washington D.C., but General Andrew Jackson was the leader God raised up to deliver us at the Battle of New Orleans. The Civil War saw our nation hopelessly divided over state's rights to choose or not chose slavery.
